Google Classroom

Please understand that Google Classroom is designed to support contact between the children and their teacher and provide a central point for the Home Learning. The teachers are able to post messages to their class and individual children and can also upload learning activities and resources. Parents/carers wishing to contact their child's teacher should do so using the office email address rather than Google Classroom.

As you will be aware, our teachers have been in telephone contact with all the parents of children in their class. This is to provide reassurance and guidance in respect to Home Learning and to explore ways in which we might be able to provide additional support for families who are in need.
