### Year 6 World War 2 Learning Journey



On Wednesday, Y6 dressed up as evacuees, ARP wardens and billeting staff and travelled to the National Archives in Kew. During a workshop, the children learnt about different types/ means of propaganda and how these were used to motivate the British public to keep their spirits up and work together for the war effort. Staff at the Records Office commented positively on the children's engagement, their subject knowledge and understanding, their questions and excellent behaviour (and, of course, their costumes).

On Thursday, Lotte Moore (local resident, author and child evacuee during WW2) visited Year 6 to tell the children about her personal war time experiences. Through her animated talk, visual presentation and a series of artefacts, the children advanced their understanding of the time period. Thank you very much Lotte!
