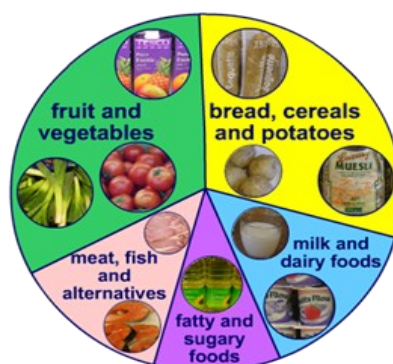
Every Friday we have Cavendish Code Assembly where we share good news about who has been following our Cavendish Code:
