On 15th December, Cavendish children were "Spotty" for the day and raised £130 for Children in Need!



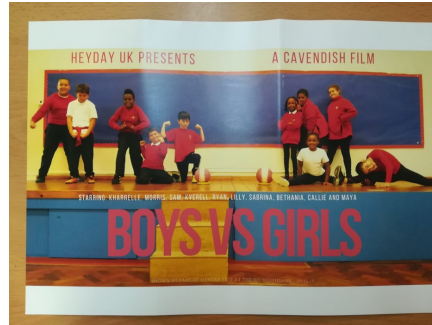

Year 5 children went to the 'Heyday Fest' at the British Film Institute on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> December. The Fest is an annual film festival involving 12 London schools creating their own short films. A professional film-making team had come to Cavendish in October to work with 10 students. By the end of the day, they had made a 4-5 minute short film.

At the Fest the whole class saw the finished product along with all the other schools involved. It was a fantastic 'premiere'. Two of Cavendish pupils stood up on stage and delivered a two minute speech telling the audience what the film was about and what they enjoyed about the film-making process.
